

Procedure People – Work Health and Safety

Scope

This procedure applies to all Board Members, SDN staff members, including maximum term and casual staff members, students and volunteers. It also applies to all contractors or visitors.

Responsibilities

SDN staff members

- ensuring that SDN is a drug, alcohol and smoke free workplace
- immediately reporting any person who is suspected to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol or found to be smoking on SDN premises.

SDN Leaders

• managing staff members who are suspected to be or confirmed to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Human Resources (HR)


• providing support/advice on managing staff members who are suspected to be or confirmed to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.


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Intoxication/Under Influence of Drugs
